### **Footpaths/Drains/Laneway queries**

#### **Q.51 Question in the name of Councillor Jane Horgan Jones**

**“To ask the Area Manager to respond to the following issues that have arisen in Seapark Drive/Seapark Road**

1. Seapark Drive – Footpaths on this road are broken up and shore covers cracked – can they be repaired? Also there is a lane running parallel to 41 Seapark Drive (entrance near Seafield Downs) and there is a huge dumping problem here. Is this lane in charge and if so can the rubbish be cleared from it?
2. Seapark Road: I am requesting that the drains on street be cleared out. This hasn't been done since last year and they have become blocked up over winter.

3. Laneway behind 30 Seapark DriveL This laneway is half public, half private. It is regularly used as a shortcut by people. People drive up to the middle of the lane and dump things. There is a sofa, a fridge and a microwave there at the moment. Can this be looked at?
4. Seapark Drive: There have been a number of burglaries in this area - Access is gained to houses via the laneway behind the houses. Is this laneway public or private and if it is public can lighting be installed there?

**Reply:**

1. Road Maintenance Services has inspected this location. A number of repairs have been scheduled for the coming 10-12 weeks. Waterworks Division will inspect this and any necessary repairs to shore covers will be carried out
2. 24 of 25 gullies at Seapark Road were cleaned on 12<sup>th</sup> June 2013. All gullies cleaned are now working to operational standards.
3. We had this laneway inspected on the 11<sup>th</sup> June 2013 and can confirm any rubbish there is on the private end of this laneway.
4. This laneway is not in the charge of Dublin City Council.
